MAJOR CASE SQUAD INVESTIGATING ASSAULT IN BEVERLY HILLS

At 8:40 pm this evening, the North County Police Cooperative responded to the 6100 block of Page Ave for the report of shots fired. Upon the officers' arrival, they located two victims with gunshot wounds.

The Officers rendered aid. One victim died at the scene and the second victim was transported to a local hospital and is in serious, but stable condition.

The identity of the victims is being withheld pending notification of relatives.

Officers on the scene secured the area and notified Detectives. Shortly thereafter, the North County Police Cooperative requested the assistance of the Major Case Squad of Greater St. Louis.

Lt. Chris Armstrong of the Ladue Police Department, is the Commander assigned to this investigation. He will be assisted by 18 Major Case Squad investigators working with North County Police Cooperative Detectives on this case.
