MAJOR CASE SQUAD CALLED TO INVESTIGATE DOUBLE HOMICIDE IN VINITA PARK

On Sunday, October 21, 2018 at approximately 1:00 AM, the North County Police Cooperative responded to a call for a shooting in the 2100 block of Penfield. Upon arrival, officers found two subjects, who were the apparent victims of gunshot wounds, deceased at the scene. The Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad was requested by Chief John Buchannan, to assist with the investigation. Captain Mike Thompson, of the Chesterfield Police Department, is the deputy commander assigned.

Currently 20 investigators with the Major Case Squad are investigating the incident. The names of the victims, a 35-year-old, black female and a 45-year-old, black male, are not being released at this time. The Major Case Squad is seeking any information from the community to assist in identifying those responsible.
