### **SUSPECT CHARGED IN BERKELEY HOMICIDE**

On Wednesday, May 17, 2017, at approximately 2:00 a.m., the Berkeley Police Department requested activation of The Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad to assist with an investigation wherein one subject was the victim of an apparent homicide. The shooting occurred in the 6000 block of Madison around 10:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 16, 2017.

The victim:

TERRANCE ROBINSON  
25-YEARS-OLD

ST. LOUIS, MO 63137

died as a result of multiple gunshot wounds.

The Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad investigation led to the arrest and charging of one suspect:

CHRISTOPHER JOHNSON  
24-YEARS-OLD  
9700 BLK OF BALBOA DR.  
ST. LOUIS, MO 63136

with one count Murder 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and one count of Armed Criminal Action. Johnson remains in custody at the St. Louis County Justice Center. He is being held without bond.
