MAJOR CASE SQUAD CALLED TO INVESTIGATE BERKELEY HOMICIDE

On Wednesday, May 17, 2017, at approximately 2:00 a.m., the Berkeley Police Department requested activation of The Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad to assist with an investigation wherein one subject was the victim of an apparent homicide. The shooting occurred in the 6000 block of Madison.
