MAJOR CASE SQUAD TROY FIRE RELATED DEATH

UPDATE: The Major Case Squad has been deactivated. The victim has been positively identified as Jonathan Krocak, a 27 year old from Troy, Mo. The cause of the fire is still under investigation. Mr. Krocak was identified by DNA and we are still awaiting toxicology reports from the St. Louis County Medical Examiner's Office. The Major Case Squad will reevaluate the case once the Missouri State Fire Investigators report is finalized and the toxicology reports are returned. PREVIOUS:

On Saturday, June 15th, at approximately 03:15AM, Troy Police Officers responded to a vehicle fire near 100 Frenchmans Bluff Lane. Officers and Fire Department Personnel discovered a burned body in the driver seat of the vehicle. Troy Police Chief Jeff Taylor requested the St. Louis Major Case Squad to assist with the investigation.

Commander Ray Juengst of the St. Charles Police Department and 14 investigators with Major Case Squad are investigating both the death and cause of the fire. The identity of the victim is unknown at this time.
