Major Case Squad Called To Investigate Homicide in Alton, IL

On Sunday, August 26, 2018, the Greater St Louis Major Case Squad was activated to assist the Alton Police Department with the investigation into the apparent Homicide of Keron Hickman. 28 investigators from 17 different agencies assisted in this investigation. Through this investigation, 5 suspects were identified. 3 of the 5 suspects have been apprehended at this time. The facts of the investigation were presented to the Madison County State's Attorney's Office and the following arrest warrants were issued:
