PERSON OF INTEREST TAKEN INTO CUSTODY FOR DEATH OF CALVERTON PARK HOMICIDE VICTIM IDENTIFIED AS KENNETH A. LINZIE

Investigators with The Major Case Squad of Greater St. Louis have taken a person of interest into custody following the discovery of a body in Calverton Park on Sunday, Jan. 13, 2019.

The victim, positively identified as:

was discovered dead from a fatal gunshot wound, around 12:30 p.m., in a garage behind a residence on Williams Boulevard. This remains an active and ongoing investigation. On Sunday, January 13, 2019, the Calverton Park Police Department requested the activation of The Greater St. Louis Major Case Squad to assist with a homicide investigation. Shortly before 12:30 p.m., a black male subject was discovered dead in a garage behind a residence on Williams Boulevard. The victim's name will be released pending positive identification and family notification. His cause of death is yet to be determined.
