On Friday, June 10, 2022 the Madison Police Department requested the activation of the Major Case Squad of Greater St. Louis for a homicide that occurred at the Madison Meat Market located at 308 Madison Avenue in Madison, Illinois.

On Thursday, June 9, 2022 at approximately 11:03 PM Madison Police Officers were dispatched to the business for a report of shots fired. Upon arrival, a 28-year-old male was located in a vehicle on the parking lot suffering from injuries sustained from a gunshot wound. The victim, later identified as Reginald P. Beasley III of East St. Louis, Illinois, was transported to a St. Louis area hospital where he was later pronounced deceased. A second 35-year-old male suffered a non-life-threatening gunshot wound during the incident. He received medical treatment at a local hospital and was released.

The Major Case Squad of Greater St. Louis is requesting assistance identifying a black in color passenger vehicle involved in this case. The vehicle possibly has a white defect on the hood. Photos of the vehicle have been included.

Investigators are currently following up on leads during the initial stages of the investigation.
